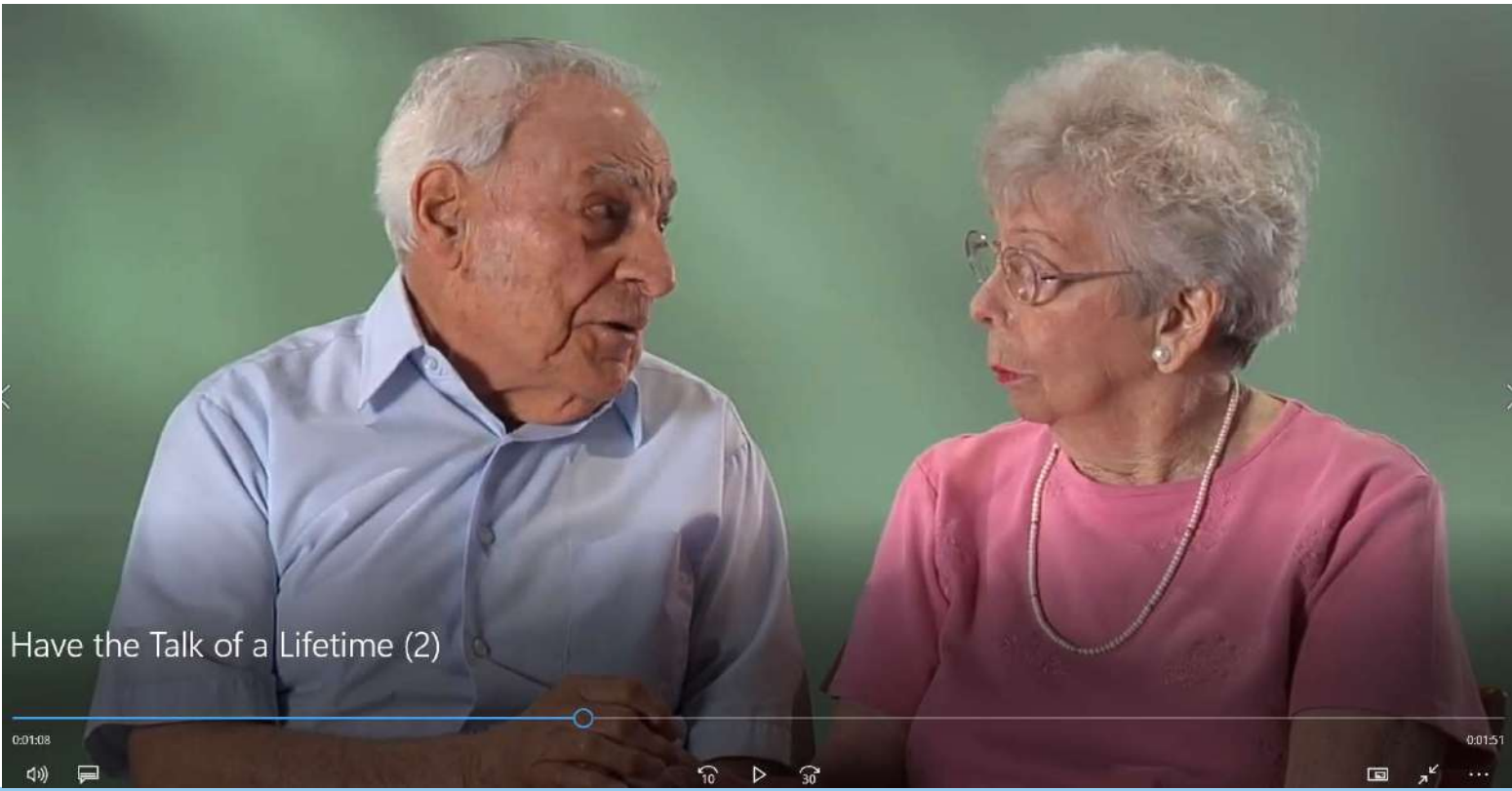

Example/ Model of Good Preparation

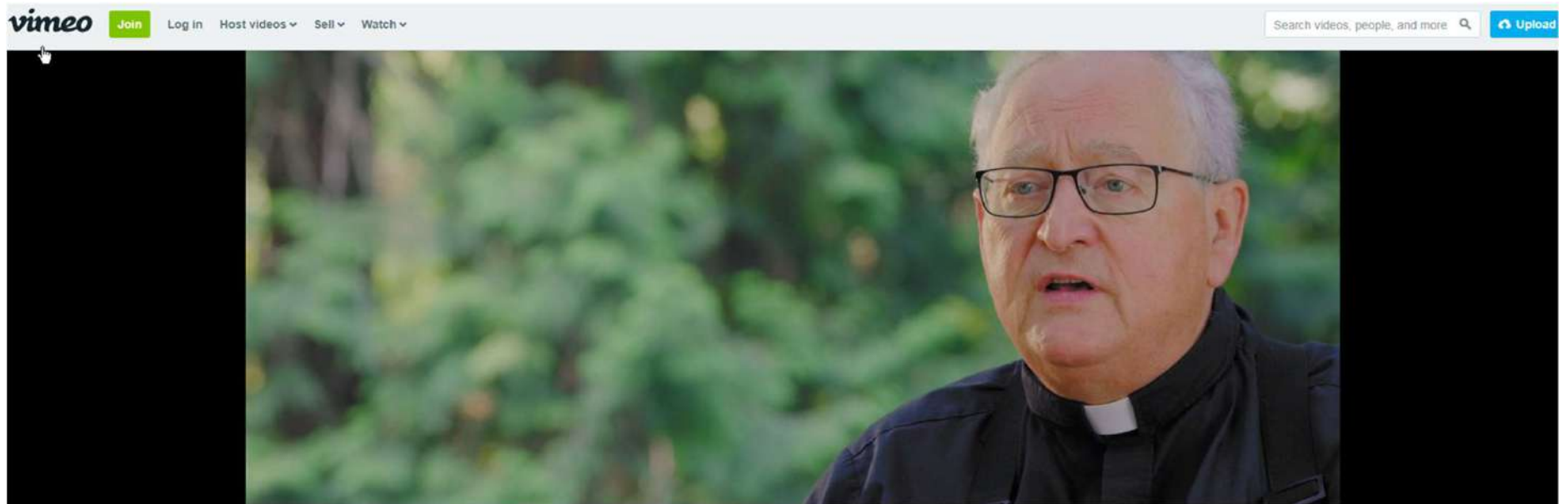


Intentions: How do you want to be remembered?


