*(without anxiety and avoidance for earthly end-of-life).*



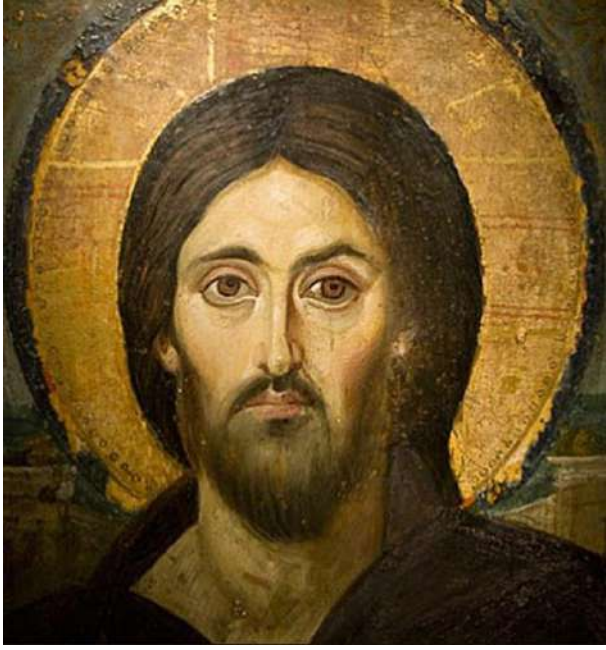


## What we Do

provide sacred space for prayer and worship.*

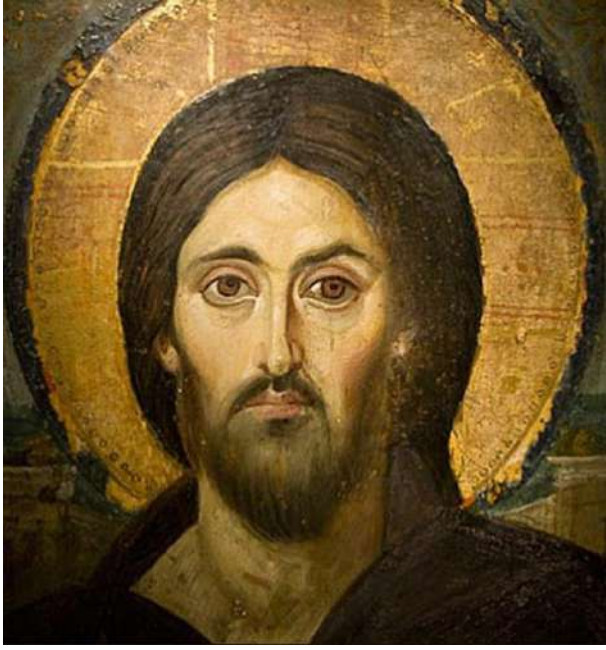


# Background



- ✓ *The Gardens of Gethsemani is the Archdiocese main cemetery*
- ✓ *A historical section with 14 Stations of the Cross needs refurbishing. These stations were originally donated by Archbishop Duke in the late 1960s.*
- ✓ *This area offers visitors an area to pray the Stations of the Cross devotion, particularly during the Season of Lent.*
- ✓ *The site is located across from a new area called the Stations of the Resurrection – the Way of Light. In essence, Patrons can do the Stations of the Cross during Lent, then after Easter – they can prayer the Stations of the Resurrection also known as the Way of Light or Via Lucis.*
- ✓ *Gardens is seeking sponsorship of the to help beautify the Gardens, to provide a devotional prayer area, and to improve the gardens in that area. It is adjacent to the historic Resurrection Chapel and Crypt Mausoleum housing 4 former Archbishops of the Archdiocese of Vancouver.*

# Stations of the Cross - Sponsorship

14 bronze reliefs	\$13k
Stations I to XIV – granite pillar, installation, sub base	
site preparation, materials	\$35k
Landscape improvements	\$7k
Acknowledgement Plaque replacement – Archbishop Duke	\$3k
<u>Benches (2)</u>	<u>\$11k</u>
Total	\$69k

The sponsorship includes 2 inurnments for cremation or 1 inground plot anywhere within the Gardens of Gethsemani. Plus donor recognition plaque.
