

Background



- ✓ The Gardens of Gethsemani is the Archdiocese main cemetery
- ✓ A historical section with 14 Stations of the Cross needs refurbishing. These stations were originally donated by Archbishop Duke in the late 1960s.
- ✓ This area offers visitors an area to pray the Stations of the Cross devotion, particularly during the Season of Lent.
- ✓ The site is located across from a new area called the Stations of the Resurrection the Way of Light. In essence, Patrons can do the Stations of the Cross during Lent, then after Easter they can prayer the Stations of the Resurrection also known as the Way of Light or Via Lucis.
- ✓ Gardens is seeking sponsorship of the to help beautify the Gardens, to provide a devotional prayer area, and to improve the gardens in that area. It is adjacent to the historic Resurrection Chapel and Crypt Mausoleum housing 4 former Archbishops of the Archdiocese of Vancouver.




