FEATURES

- A. Stone from the Gardens of Gethsemani Holy Land**
This small white stone connects us to the place of Christ's passion and betrayal.
- B. Pagoda of Eternal Life**
Chinese Catholics honour loved ones twice a year at Tombfest held in May and September.
- C. Veterans' Memorial**
A Remembrance Day Mass with procession takes place on November 11th each year to commemorate veterans.
- D. St. Thérèse of Lisieux – the Little Flower**
At the moment of her death, she said: "I am not dying, I am entering new life."
- E. Mosaics of St. Joseph of Arimathea & St. Nicodemus**
The artwork memorializes these saints who buried Jesus.
- F. St. Andrew Kim**
This patron of Korea was martyred because of his dedication to spreading Catholicism.
- G. St. Anthony of Padua**
A Portuguese priest and friar of the Franciscan order, known as the saint to pray for if you are missing something.
- H. Our Lady of La Vang**
Mary, who appeared in 1798 to console Christians persecuted in Vietnam.
- I. Our Lady of Peace**
Mother of Peace, Queen of Peace or Our Lady Queen of Peace are titles of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
- J. Good Shepherd**
Christ is described as the Good Shepherd who lays down his life for His sheep.
